

Codicil to the Last Will and Testament

A Codicil is an instruction or amendment which is added to your existing Will and in effect becomes part of that Will. Please discuss any changes to your Will with your solicitor.

Please note: As a codicil is a separate document to the Will, it is important that the Codicil is attached to the Will to ensure it is not mislaid or overlooked at the time of Probate Application is made and the estate of a deceased person is administered.
